H/F Kings Arms pub with two petrol pumps (Stanley Hall)

M/P Red Lion ??

M/P The Unicorn Hotel (The Billingtons)

H/S British Legion Club

N/S Volunteer (next to the Chinese restaurant)

N/S Three Tuns (Jock Callow)

Shops

H/S Goundreys Electrical Shop (Accumulators etc) Mr Oldham next to the Tchure

H/S Grocers shop (next to Legion Club) Mr John Lewis

H/S Garage. 2 Petrol pumps (corner of Hudson St) Mr Holiday

N/S Sweet Shop. Mr Saunders into Hudson St

N/S Greengrocers shop, over road from Volunteer (Mr and Mrs Compton)

H/S N/S Butchers shop in corner by Archway opposite now Chinese restaurant. (Mr Smith and Miss Bolton) by butchers

H/S Tool repairs and saw sharpening etc (Mr Stanley in cottage down walkway.)

N/S Blacksmiths. Mr Tibbets Petrol Pumps, then Archway Garage (now dentists)

N/S Chemist shop (Mr Shaw) Mr Belton. Two doors down from Volunteer

N/S Ironmongers (Mr Beardsley) Get almost anything there. 2 doors up from Three Tuns

N/S Grocery Shop (Miss Fowler) 1 door down from Three Tuns

N/S Bakers shop on corner of the Stile (Mr Course)

M/P Post Office (Mr Bolton where Eagles is now)

M/P Sweet shop (The Misses Frenches) Now Clydesdale

M/P Tuckers stores (Mr Boone) deliveries around the villages. Now Otters Restaurant

M/P Co-op Manager (Mr George) deliveries round village with bread and milk

M/P/ Greengrocers and paraffin etc. (Arthur Canning) [*Ed's note now Southgate*]

C/S Hopcraft and Powell Butchers. Later Pretoria House

Farms

50s (Mr Cole) Grandad to owner of Tomwell Farm

Manor Farm. From crossroads up Hempton Rd. Land all round Cosy Lane and to the Bungalow etc

Grove Farm (Mr Butlin) up Grove and included the track to Plumdon Lane etc

Castle Farm (Mr Holloway) Clifton Road and towards Stilgoes

Mr Gardners land Clifton Rd road round to Oxford Rd

Mr Frenches Farm (Clifton Rd to Chapmans Lane) Hopcrafts Lane opposite Johnsons (All now part of Caulcott's enterprise ??)

Leadenporch (Mr Tustain) still there now Deeleys of Souldern

Park Farm. Mr Bletsoe and Miss Pacey now Jason Maloney, squeezed between Grove and Manor farm.

Jack Bliss had land by Castle Grounds and Plumdon Lane

Sid Canning had a pig enterprise on land down the old road & Pest House

Shops - continued

Chapel Square. Grocers Shop (Mr Boffin) recently Centrepoint.

Mr Boffin then had a shop built in Hempton Road – (now Chinese Restaurant)

Mr Callow. Coal yard Philcote Street. Coal deliveries

Mr Fred Deely. Haulier and Coalyard (Castle End). Now Richard Spencer's home

M/P Miss Mathews. Haberdashery, Toys, Clothes etc. (Now Mark David estate agent)

M/P W G Wells, Tailors and Clothing – all sorts. (Now Philip Allen publishing)

Both Tuckers and Wells had BanburyBanks there on Fridays for all local businesses to put their cash in!

M/P Haywards Greengrocers, then general store by the Tchure

M/P Wallins shop. Bakery – delivered round lots of villages. Now Hamptons

B/R Cobbler Mr Ell Wirral House Bull Ring 3 pence to get your belt repaired

N/S Mr Hoare, village milk round with a pushcart?

B/R Mr Slee, Second Hand furniture (Bull Ring block)

Castle St/Chapel Square: Johnsons Timber yard. Still there!

Doctors surgery: Featherstone House then Osborne House opposite the library. Then to present place.

H/Fair/H/street. Courtroom and police house. Now library

Several allotments - all occupied.

Hempton Rd, whole field where Windmill Street is now

Earls Lane – opposite the surgery

Clifton Rd down from Castle Farm

Chapmans Lane

St Thomas Street (still there)

Windmill Secondary School – where Mill Close is now
